



Hugh Coffey, Sr.

1750-1827

South Carolina

Hugh Coffey, Sr. served as a soldier in the South Carolina Militia during 1780 through 1782. He served under Lt. Col. Henry Hampton at Blackstock's Plantation. He then served under Lt. Col. Frederick Kimball at Camden, South Carolina from April 23 to May 11 and July 4 to July 31, 1781. At various times he also supplied services and goods to the military. The Tories ultimately took all of his property. Hugh Coffey, Sr. was born in Harper's Ferry, Virginia on May 15, 1750 and died in Lancaster, South Carolina on April 26, 1827. His wife, Agnes Montgomery, was born in Scotland or South Carolina on May 15, 1755. Hugh Coffey, Sr. is the 5<sup>th</sup> Great Grandfather of Clifford Caskey.
