



Thomas Landrum

1759 – 1833

Virginia

Thomas Landrum was born in Orange County VA on 6 Oct 1759. He was drafted for 1 year on 25 Feb 1778. Discharged Feb. 1779 and marched home under command of CPT Robert Powell.

May 1780 drafted into Militia for 3 months. CPT Webb company commander. Discharged after Battle of Jamestown at Malvern Hills.

Pvt. 7th VA Regt. Continental Army 23 Feb, 1778 – 23 Feb. 1779. VA Militia May 1780-Aug 1780. VA Militia Fall 1781 for 3 months.

Monmouth, NJ – CPT Burley Company Gen. Woodford Brigade. Militia; CPT Webb Company, General LaFayette Army Battle at Jamestown. Militia; fall of 1781 CPT Cave.

Fall of 1781 drafted again for 3 months in Militia. Marched to Little York where he conducted prisoners to Winchester.

Thomas moved to Oglethorpe County Georgia in January 1803. Served as Col GA troops in War of 1812.
