Isaac Clark was born March 31, 1731 in Lyme, New London, CT to Thomas and Rebecca (Watrous) Clark. Isaac was the great grandson of John Clark, who was the first mate on the Mayflower. Clark's Island is so named after John Clark who departed the boat and was the first Englishman to speak to Squanto. John's story can be found in William Bradford's Diary.

Isaac married Rebecca Cadman in about 1766. Isaac was a private in the 17th Regiment of the Albany County Militia, Land Bounty Rights.

After the Revolutionary War was over, Isaac and Rebecca retired to Austerlitz, Columbia, NY where he lived until his death in 1814. Rebecca passed on January 4, 1806. Isaac is buried in the St. Peter Presbyterian cemetery in Spencertown, NY.
